- Working on getting instruments repaired for elementary and secondary.
- Working on an arts festival. 2-3 week period to promote (March 7-17) performances and exhibits all over the district.
- Wants to know the articulation of the different courses in the course description.
- We now have 5 Local Education Service Centers.
- Textbook allocations are in the same fund at the school sites. There is no per pupil money from the Arts Branch. It can be found in the 4170 funds at schools.
- Recommendation for choral teachers to brush up on instrumental teaching skills because there are few choral teaching positions.

Scott Burstein from Little Kids Rock Report

- Largest music organization that donates musical instruments.
- Modern band workshops to learn guitar, drum set, improvisation, etc. It is for credentialed teachers only. Mostly music teachers but some others as enrichment. Teachers that attend get a donated class set of instruments and curriculum.
- First workshop is October 20-21.

Paul Strand Report

- Music demonstration teacher that has taken on many of Julie Corallo's responsibilities.
- Professional development will be provided 4 times this year. 2:30-4:00 pm on Tuesdays.
